

NOMINATION FOR THE LAURA SPENCER AWARD

To be awarded to the AFSCME Union Member or Officer in good standing in state Human Services who best exemplifies a unionist with heart, a true friend, leader and mentor.

Each local within SUMMUP may submit the name of only one member of their local. The nominees must be a member in good standing and an employee of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts. In addition, any SUMMUP delegate may also nominate any individual who meets all of the above criteria.

To be eligible for nomination the following applies:

- A. Must be a member in good standing at the time of nomination of a local in good standing with SUMMUP.
- B. A member must have been unconditionally active in any aspect of his/her local union or SUMMUP activities for a minimum of five years.

No person who is a paid employee of Council 93 may be eligible for the award during the time of his/her employment.
